- 3 Minutes of the Committee meeting held on 16th November 2019 in Vienna were proposed as a true record by Andreas Schweitzer (Austria) and seconded by Jean Schmitt (France), proposal was carried.
- 4 There were no matters arising from the Minutes.
- 5 The Vice Secretary General Report:
 - a. The VSG referred to the draft Statutes, which the SG and he went through at a meeting in January and will be put to the delegates at the 2022 Congress for voting.
- 6 To consider the income and expenditure Accounts for the year ending 31st December 2019 and to adopt the Accounts together with the Reports of the Treasurer and Auditor. The Financial Statement and Balance Sheet had been circulated:
 - a. The Treasure's Report by way of the Income & Expenditure and Balance Sheet are annexed as "A".
 - b. The Accounts had been audited by John Grottum (Norway) and he reported all was in order.
 - c. The Treasurer advised that the IKD PayPal account is used by one member organisation and is an administrative burden to retain. After a short discussion it was agreed that if that one member can be
