Comments on Regulation, if any:

The regulation and licensing process is now fully operational in France. All professionals legally allowed to practise have been granted with two licence numbers. One is individual the other is for each registered agency operating.

The figures from the licensing authority are now available in details (2016):

number of individual licences for P.I.'s: 759
number of licensed agencies: 1,068
number of employees card: 5,025

The most important update last year regarding regulations is that the continued education (ongoing training) has become mandatory for every P.I. working as employee, every 5 years, to renew the licence.

That is why SNARP has created a P.I. school several years back, the "ESARP". This school is now fully operational and the first session of preliminary training (for new P.I.s) has started in 2017. A partnership was signed with the Police Academy of St Cyr l'Ecole.

SNARP is proud to be represented at the CNAPS National College, acting as a management board but also in the National Licensing and Inspection Commission (CNAC) that oversees compliance with the general guidelines set by the CNAPS.

Lastly, SNARP has become affiliated since 2018 to the French Federation of Private Security, which includes main players in the sector.
